

CRO.Y.A. CRAFT COCKTAIL COMPETITION RULES



Entry:

- All crew members of yachts registered in the show are eligible to enter.
- Competition is limited to the first 15 entries.
- Participants will be assigned time slots for the judging to take place Sept 30th 10:30–16:30 every 15 minutes, based on their location on the dock. (TBD)
- Registration deadline will cut off with the first 15 participants or no later than September 28th. Register online <https://croya.hr/show-competitions/>

Details:

- **Time slots will be announced September 30th. Competition judges will arrive at each yacht at the appointed time on September 30th. Participants will have just 5 minutes to serve their creations. Allowing 5 minutes for the judges to taste and review as well as 5 minutes travel between yachts. Please provide the completed competition forms with recipes to the Judges on arrival.**
- **Any specialty ingredients and necessary supplies should be prepared in advance. The mixing and presentation of these ingredients should be done after the judges have arrived and two identical cocktails should be presented within 5 minutes.**

Participants should also present the completed competition form to include:

- Yacht Name
- Crew Member Name
- Crew Member Contact Phone and email
- Cocktail Name
- List of ingredients
- Brief preparation notes and instructions
- Release Signature – CROYA and the judging panel have full permission and right to use all photos and recipes with credit given to the originator (Crew member and Yacht).

Each entry will be judged on the following criteria:

- Original Cocktail Name – 1–2 points
- Skill and technique: 1–5 points
- Balance: 1–5 points
- Taste: 1–10 points
- Creativity 1–5 points
- Presentation 1–5 points

There are no required guidelines so bring your creativity, however local ingredients are encouraged. Ingredients should consist of items that could realistically be provided on charter.
